- Elaborate on what "local supply chain" is here: In early December 2020, Janaki received training on hygienically processing and packaging of dried fish as a stronger alternative livelihood option. Project staff linked her to a local supply chain of dry fish which procured through online/ telephone orders. Although she has since resumed gold mining, Janaki continues to sell fish. She mobilized other female artisanal mines in her community to procure and process dried fish which she then sells to the local supply chain making profitable for everyone involved.
