Thank you for successfully completing this project. We have read your report and reviewed knowledge products and are pleased with the results you have achieved in helping ASM communities in the KBK regions of Odisha to cope with the impact of the pandemic and be more resilient in the face of similar shocks through the research, awareness raising, capacity building and networking efforts you have carried out. We are also very pleased with the creation of the new association of women in the mining sector.

We also enjoyed reading the collection of lessons learned and success stories as well as visualizing the various photos and videos that give some more human dimension to the report.

Below are some comments/questions from the team:

- The number of activities conducted, and people reached, is impressive. Most of the expected results have been exceeded or achieved.
- It would be useful to understand how the various knowledge products from the project will be used by the different stakeholders, including the government of India, and how they will inform government policy and programs towards formalizing ASM and improving the overall sector in India.
- Kindly add a World Bank disclaimer statement in the knowledge products, especially the reports you developed. See example : "All opinions, views, and comments expressed in this report solely belong to the authors and do not necessarily reflect those of the World Bank. The World Bank does not guarantee the accuracy of the data included in this work".
- Kindly send the 10 sets of IEC materials in a package. We tend to confuse them with the training materials.
- We are interested and would like to collect data on the number of alternative livelihoods that have been created through the project and the total volume of finance that was facilitated by the project. In Appendix D, we counted 7 new alternative livelihoods with 99 people engaged. Is this the final number we should consider? And would you be able to break down the number of people engaged in alternative livelihoods by gender? Do you also have data on the volume of finance facilitated by the project? How much money has been generated by the beneficiaries (total amount in USD, number of people involved in IGA disaggregated by gender / how many women and how many men?)?

We are happy to approve the report pending the above information. When you send the updated reports and details on the alternative livelihoods created, feel free to send along your invoice for the final installment of \$17,905.908
