Based on the findings of the study, it is recommended that SRADHA and similar projects:

- **Provide more opportunities for** youth from isolated areas and more vulnerable communities to share their life stories on issues relating to violence, extremism, conflict, and how to use the peacebuilding process to prevent violence and promote peace in their community.
- **Increase collaboration with** local authorities and agencies. This would go a long way to reduce the risk associated with working with young people, and particularly young females. Local authorities are key players in program implementation in local communities.
